### M E M O R A N D U M

August 15, 2013 Attn: NRDRWSC Commission Re: Operational Report since May 27<sup>th</sup> to Current

Since the last update provided to members of the Commission (May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013), the City of Lacombe has dealt with the following issues:

#### GENERAL ISSUES

Alberta One Call requests May = 268 June = 165 July = 160 August 1st to 14th = 74

- ➤ Call out charges:
  - July 1st, Brian Riggins was called by the Red Deer Treatment Plant (6:00am) Pumphouse "A" (Lacombe) actuator valve failure to open; Manually fill reservoir; stop fill at 11:30pm
- Repair Response charges:
  - May 22nd, Brian Riggins was called by Town of Blackfalds; air release valve at Railway is leaking; Brian tore down the valve and cleaned.
  - August 7th, Brian Riggins receives a call from Red Deer Treatment Plant; Lucas actuator valve is only opening 65% compared to normal operation of 95%.
  - August 14th, Brian and Summit valve visit Lucas to see if they can temporarily repair actuator valve until the purchase of a Retork actuator valve is approved.
- ➤ General Information:
  - June 21st, call received from Mobile Data Solutions regarding the flooding in Downtown Calgary, their office is on ground floor in the Downtown area, they were not confident that the flood water would spare their building and that the NRDRWSC could potentially lose communication with all sites if the building gets flooded. NRDRWSC did not lose communication in the following days.
  - July 23rd, water samples were taken at various sites and delivered to the Health unit in Red Deer, unfortunately all municipalities that used the Northside Health Unit did not have their samples sent to the ProvLab in Edmonton.
  - July 25th, retake the water samples from the 23rd.
  - August 8th, Call Summit, Corix and Emco for pricing on a Retork or comparable valve to replace the Bray actuator at Lucas.
  - August 8th, no signal from Pumphouise "C" (Lacombe); change UPS batteries in NRDRWSC cabinet.
  - August 13th, receive prices from Summit and Emco, waiting on Corix. Every company is quoting the same Retork valve for \$7,600. Unfortunately no company was found to give pricing on a comparable valve to the Retork.

#### Re: Allocation of Water for Lacombe County

Lacombe County is in the process of installing utility servicing to the area west of the Town of Blackfalds as per our Joint Economic Area Agreement. This servicing includes both water and sewer that will be provided through the Town of Blackfalds.

Lacombe County is requesting that the NRDRWSC consider that the volumes of water delivered to this area be drawn from the allocation that Lacombe County has within the Commission. The current connection point is with the Town of Blackfalds; however, there are future plans to tie directly into the regional line at one of the connection points when this development area reaches the point that it requires a reservoir. It is our understanding that the Commission does provide funding to members when these connections are made.
