NORTH RED DEER RIVER WATER SERVICES COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING MINUTES June 25, 2018

1. Call to Order:

Chair Wigmore called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

5. Reports

<u>Operations Report</u> Mr. Huston discussed the recent operation activities.

In summary:

- The Alberta One-Call locate have been steady.
- Operations replaced an inoperable dehumidifier at the main vault.
- The Operator received call outs for the following:

- o Emergency locates in Ponoka
- o Communication lost for the entire line
- Pumphouse "B" outflow was high and the regional line was unable to keep up. Had to shut down one of the pumps to restore the station to normal operation.

SCADA RFP Recommendations

Mr. Huston presented to the Commission the recommendation to the RFP for the SCADA upgrades.

In summary:

- Received 4 submissions with costs ranging from \$131,000 to \$247,000.
- Scoring was done on Cost, Customer Service & Technical Support, Experience and Reference
- Eramosa scored the highest and was also the lowest in cost in the amount of \$131,212 although they were unable to provide a cost on the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition Recodes and Reporting (SCADARR)web based platform. Operations estimated that cost to be \$47,000 which will make the bid \$178,212.
- Upgrades would start on August 1st and run for 12 weeks.
- Operations recommends that the Commission award the SCADA upgrade contact to Eramosa.

Concerns were expressed by the Commission that the final cost could be higher then estimated and that they will not support any change orders. Operations advised the Commission that their gaol is to manage the project to ensue costs stay within the agreed amount. Operations will establish the final price with Eramosa before the contact is signed.

MOVED by Mayor Poole that Operations awards the SCADA upgrade to Eramosa if the SCADARR web-based platform is within the estimated \$47,000 cost. If the cost is above the \$47,000 amount, Operations is to return to the Commission for direction.

Administrator Report

Mr. de Bresser presented the Administrator's report.

In summary:

- Administration invested \$5 million in long term investments, 80% bonds in Schedule 1 banks and 20% principal protected notes.
- The City of Red Deer provided the water rate model for 2018. Also indicated that in accordance to section 5(4) of the water supply agreement they do not need to provide a 5 year projection.
- Continue to work with Red Deer on the sale of part of the waterline.

MOVED by Mayor Bonnett to accept the Administrator's report as information.

Mr. de Bresser presented the financial report.

In summary:

- Water sales volumes for May were up due to the drier weather.
- SCADA maintenance is over budget due to the ongoing maintenance to keeping it operational.
- Legal fees are higher due to legal consulting regarding requests to change the Crossing Agreement.

MOVED by Mayor Creasey to accept the Financial Report as information.

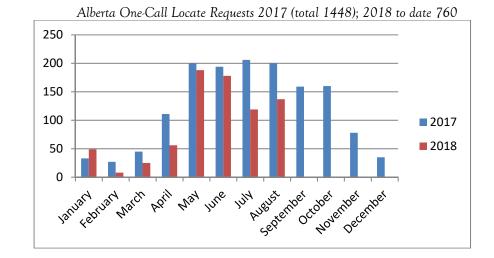

Repair response charges:

Operator began inspecting the air release chambers from Red Deer to Ponoka, and started to replace the old fibre insulation with new rigid foam insulation.

Call-Out:

- June 23 Operator called by RDWTP No communication with the main vault
 Operator reset modem and restored communication.
- July 21 Operator called by RDWTP Plant was unable to close the fill valve at Riverside (Ponoka) – Operator went to site and found valve in the 'over-torque' position – reset valve and restored control from the treatment plant.

General Information:

SCADA Upgrades - Operators have engaged Eramosa and began the process of upgrading the SCADA system.

The following is a summary of items Administration has been working on since the Board's last meeting:

- Sale of Water line is moving forward. Administration is waiting for Red Deer to provide a purchase/sale agreement for the commissions review. Alberta Transportation have approved the transaction from a grants perspective. Once all information has been collected, administration will present the package to the commission.
- 2. Administration is currently working on the 2019 budget and will be aligning budget meetings with the Wastewater Commission meetings in November and December.
- 3. Administration is awaiting a date of the annual meeting with the City of Red Deer to discuss City and regional operations, sale of water line and meter vault location.

Attached is the 2018 variance report as of July 31th for the regional water commission.

Water sales in June and July were above historical averages however the commission may find lower consumption in the upcoming months due to the early start of colder weather. Projections to the end of the year anticipate water sales being slightly ahead of budget due to higher usage in Lacombe and Blackfalds whereas Ponoka, Ponoka County and City of Red Deer may be slightly under anticipated budgets.

Majority of expenses remain in line with expectations with the exception of SCADA maintenance. Tracking over budget due to unforeseen expenses to keep system active and running until new system is completed.

The projected surplus to the end of the year is currently at \$45,441 compared to a budgeted surplus of \$69,402.
