#### 1. Governance

## 5. Reports

#### Chairman's Report

Nothing to report at this time.

#### Operator's Report

Chris Huston introduced himself and provided a brief outline of his role with the Commission.

Mr. Huston discussed the recent activities.

In summary:

- Responded to 742 Alberta One-Call Locate requests; 184 August; 212 -September; 346 October 1- 30. Majority of the call calls have been from TELUS, as they are installing fiber optic lines in Blackfalds. The calls will decrease when TELUS halts the installation till spring.
- Operation was called out by the Red Deer Treatment Plant at different times to the Lacombe Pumphouse "C" and to Ponoka Broadway due to a loss of communication. Had to reset the modem.
- Installed new parts to the Bray Electric actuator. This will be the first value replaced in 2014
- Repairs to a pin hole on the regional line. Had the value at Lucas removed and repaired then reinstalled.
- Operation is working with Stantec to develop an "on-the-shelf" drawing and specification package to correct the orientation of the mainline isolation values.

 Mr. Huston is currently working at get the drinking water plan completed for the December 31, 2013 deadline.

#### Financial Report

Mr. Minchin presented a financial report.

#### In summary:

- Water consumption is on budget.
- July set a record on water use due to the warmer weather.
- Concerns regarding the high growth and water consumption of Blackfalds were discussed. Mr. Minchin explained that water demand is driven less by industrial development and more by high intensity residential and food oriented commercial development. Per capita water consumption has been declining within the Commission for the past number of years as water prices increase.

MOVED by Councillor Wigmore to accept the reports as information.

#### 6. Old Business:

#### EVRAZ - request for water service

 Mr. Minchin provided and updated the Commission on the progress with Evraz water request. Currently the City of Red Deer does not foresee servicing that area. The Commission will have better idea what will be expected once they pass their Area Structure Plan. The Commission at this time will step back and wait until then.

#### 7. New Business:

#### Signing Officers

Mr. Minchin advised the Commission that the Chair and/or Vice Chair will be added as signers along with himself. He recommended that Matthew Goudy, the Administrator of Wastewater, be added as an alternative to him.

MOVED by Deputy Mayor Gukja to appoint the Chair, Vice Chair and Matthew Goudy as signing officers.

#### 2014 Budget

Mr. Minchin reviewed with the Commission the 2014 Provisional draft budget summary. There is a decrease of 0.8% in water rates from the City of Red Deer. The Commission has lowered its estimate for water sales in response to the lower estimate rate by the City of Red Deer. Water rates for the Commission to member municipalities will remain unchanged at \$2.03 per cubic metre. Mr. Minchin asked that the members review with their Council the provisional budget and have it approved. The Commission will meet in December to approve the 2014 Operational Budget for the NRDRWSC.

- 3. Administration does not have any new news on the Evraz water supply initiative.
- 4. Administration is working to complete the Memorandum of Understanding between the Commission, Lacombe County and Blackfalds to address the supply of water to areas in the County west of Blackfalds.
- 5. Work is already underway regarding the Commission's annual financial audit.
- 6. The Commission is on target to exceed water forecasts for the year and the Commission is on target for a \$150,000 to \$170,000 operating surplus.

RE: 2014 Operational Budget -Update REF: 47/934/2014

The Commission has received notification from Lacombe County and the City of Lacombe indicating they have no concerns with the proposed budget. The budget before the board is the same put forth in November and Administration is recommending that the budget be approved as presented.

Administration has prepared a working budget for 2014 for the Commission's review.

The initial 2014 draft operating is based on a 0.8% decrease in water rates from the City of Red Deer based on its most recent correspondence. The decrease is the result of a major rate review for all of its customers. As part of this review, Red Deer has revised down its forecast for water sales from the Commission. The Commission has incorporated the rate change into the budget. Because of these major changes, the City has indicated that the true up will be used should there be major variances (above 10%).

The Commission has lowered its estimate for water sales from 2.57 to 2.55 million cubic meters in response to the lower estimate by the City of Red Deer.

In addition to water purchases and sales volume estimates adjustments; Administration has also reviewed all expenses for the Commission and made a number of adjustments. The following a summary of those adjustments (See the 2014 Operating Budget – Summary report):

- 1. Increase of \$18,000 in interest revenue to reflect growing cash balances.
- 2. Minor reduction in telephone costs to reflect projected 2013 actual.
- 3. Increase of Management Fees based on a June 1<sup>st</sup> increase. \$1,377 increase.
- 4. Increase in audit fees of \$25
- 5. Decrease in legal expense \$500
- 6. Decrease of \$7,000 for other professional services for the following:
  - a. Defer \$37,000 for line marking
  - b. Add \$30,000 for actuator valve replacement program. 4 of 8 in 2014.

- 7. Increase Administration (accounting services) based on a June 1<sup>st</sup> increase. \$2,584 increase
- 8. Amortization remains unchanged. As this is a non-cash expense, the reserve policy will see this transferred to capital reserves at the end of the year in 2014.

Water rates for the Commission to member municipalities would remain unchanged at \$2.03 per cubic metre. The budget may have to be adjusted once the proposed rate from the City is confirmed.

The surplus does increase over 2013 budget by \$98,200. Any actual surplus would be added to the operating reserve as per policy. The surplus would also be used should there be any "true-up" charges.
